

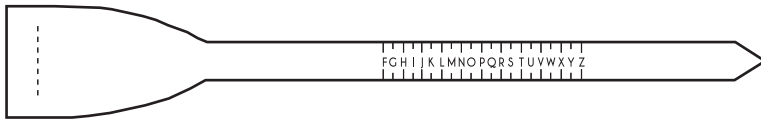

SIZE YOUR OWN RING

Here are some easy steps to find out what your size is



- A. Carefully cut out the size. Fold end and cut slit.
- B. Wrap around finger. This should be done at the bend of the day as your finger is bigger then.
- C. Slide the pointed end, through the slit.
- D. Pull tightly, it must be snug to produce an accurate size.
- E. Move to the largest part of your finger. (this may be your knuckle).
- F. The number that lines up with the slit is your size.

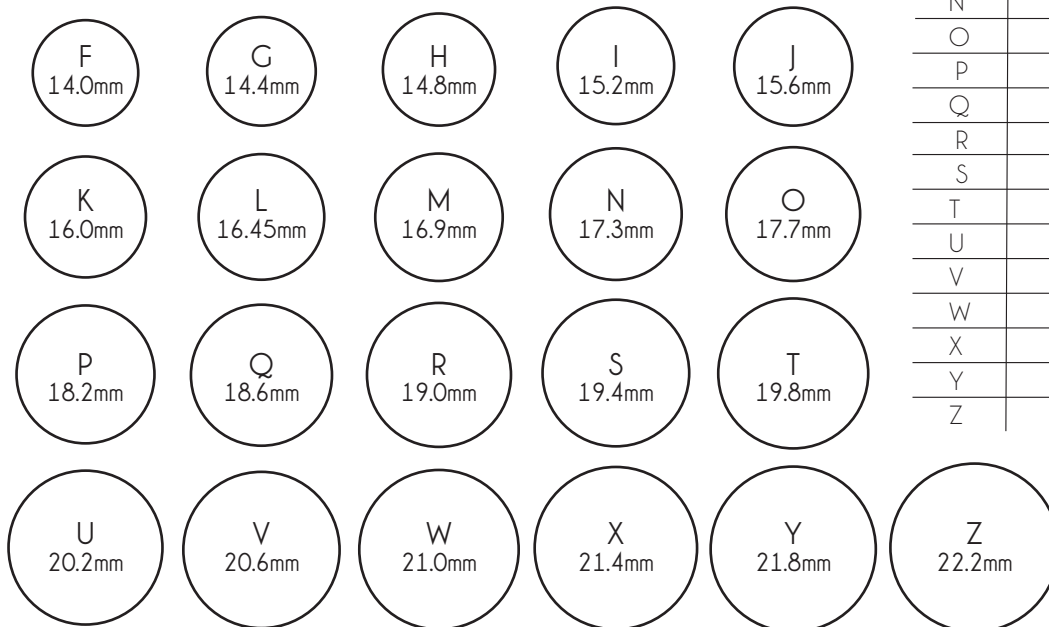

THE DIAMETER SIZE

1. Find a ring that fits the finger the ring is intended for
2. Place the ring over the circle below
3. Match the INSIDE edge of the ring to the appropriate circle
4. If your ring is between sizes, order the bigger size



Please read instructions carefully

Confirm that you are printing to size

1. Prior to printing, ensure that page scaling is set to none on your print dialog box.
2. Measure the bar on the left to ensure it is exactly 50 mm long.
3. If measurement is not accurate, check that you are printing the page at full size and reprint before continuing.
